

Pharmacy Update From Unichem Cherrywood

Stock Shortages October 2022. Due to the long-lasting global supply chain disruptions as a result of the COVID pandemic, pharmaceutical supply into New Zealand is disrupted and

uncertain. Pharmaceutical wholesalers in N7 and Pharmac are tirelessly trying to rectify this or find solutions but it does leave us short on a number of medicines at present. One way we are trying to ease these shortfalls is by restricting some medicines to monthly dispensing. By rationing medicines in this way, it ensures there is adequate supply to cover all of our patients, to make it through until more medicine reaches our shores.

The medicines that are unavailable for some time or have uncertain continuity of supply are: Gaviscon Infant sachets, Locoid Scalp lotion, Locoid Lipocream, Pevaryl Foaming sachets, Estradiol patches, Special foods, Psyllium husk, amoxicillin/clavulanic acid tablets, to name a few. Please bear with us as we try to find a solution for your prescription in conjunction with your prescriber.
